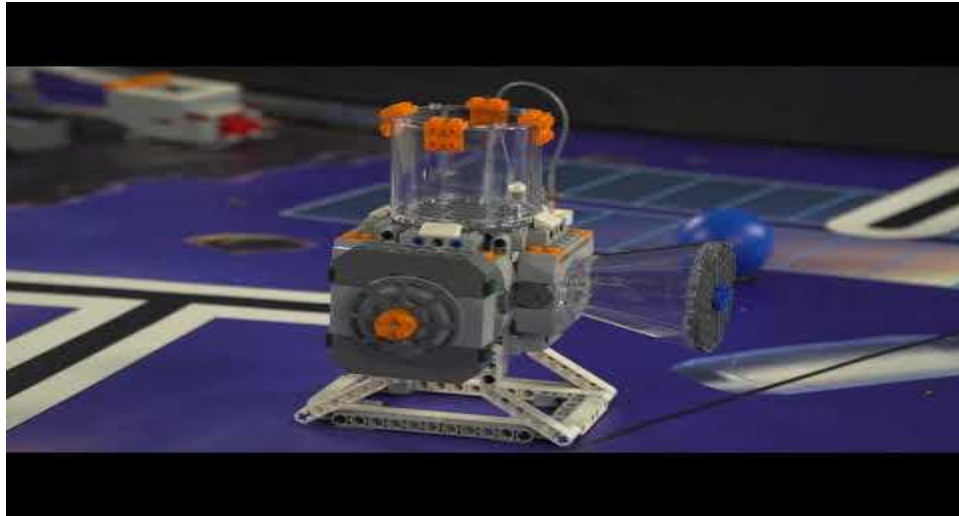


What are this year's missions?

REQUIREMENTS FOR FLL

Students need to have passing grades of a 70 or above on all progress reports and report cards. It is UIL guidelines.

Students should not have any bus referrals or administrative referrals. Good behavior is expected.

Members are required to learn to program at least one mission.

Members need to be able to learn from others, work with others, solve problems in a positive manner and be willing to share ideas in a group of about 10 students.

IS THIS THE RIGHT FIT FOR MY CHILD?

Students should be willing and able to learn to build and program an NXT Lego Mindstorms robot. There will be training, but students should have the motivation to sometimes look up information and “figure it out” on their own or with team members.

Students need to be able to listen to others and be open to compromise.

Students should be flexible and ok with having to make modifications.

There is a fee of \$40 per student to help cover expenses and materials.

WHEN ARE THE MEETINGS AND WHO ARE THE COACHES?

Meetings are on Thursdays from about 4:20-5:30. Students will be picked up in the back of school. As we get closer to competition, teams may need to meet more often, sometimes on Saturdays.
